"You will not surely die"

This is what Satan said to Eve when he tempted her to eat the fruit from the forbidden tree in the Garden of Eden, which was the exact opposite of what God told Adan in Genesis 2:16-17: "And the Lord God commanded the man, You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die."

Pastor Keith referred to these scriptures in a recent message, and when I heard him say the words (my paraphrase) "surely you won't die," it just jumped out at me and stuck in my spirit. I immediately thought back to when I smoked years ago, there were numerous warnings (in the 60'sand 70's) about how cigarettes can cause cancer, but that didn't deter me, because they didn't GUARANTEE they would kill you, they just informed you they could.

Because Adam and Eve (who represented all of humanity who came afterwards) sinned, we are ALL sinners. Here's what Romans 5:12 says: "Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned.." Without Jesus Christ as your Savior, there is a written GUARANTEE that you WILL DIE as a sinner, and be destined for hell! But if that's you, I have some good news for you...

Romans 6:23 says: "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." In John 3:3 Jesus told Nicoemus: "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again." We are created as eternal beings, and we will all live for eternity somewhere, and the choice is ours.
